I want to connect some thoughts for you before I have some of you who were at the conference share what was special to you. The last couple of times that we have been on the Trumpeter's Call my aim has been to help you see that when Paul went on his first, second and third apostolic missionary journeys he was responding to the call of God on his life.

God had to stop Paul very decisively on the road to Damascus because Paul was on his way to capture and persecute more Christians. Although Paul had knowledge of God and the religious system of the day, he did not know him personally for himself prior to this encounter. God knew that if he was to reach Paul's heart and mind he would have to make sure that his deliverance was dramatic and his salvation was convincing. Paul was so set in his ways that God had to let him come to the place where he hit a wall in the spirit. Paul had to get knocked off his proverbial donkey so that despite his training, pedigree, etc. he would trust God. Acts 9

As leaders we can not let our people dog other members of the Kingdom of God... Paul warns the church about the concision in Philippians 3:2. In Romans 16:17 it actually says to mark those people who sow discord. Paul came to visions, revelations, and insights and secrets. These visions, revelations and secrets that Paul received were not just about the atmosphere, the cosmos or the heavens, they were mysteries that pertain to the local and global church. He received the mystery of the Gentiles. Paul was setting up patterns, courts, chambers and treasures. I Chronicles 28:11-13.

I Corinthians 12:28 and Ephesians 4:11 he set some apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and some teachers. No one is all these things this is why it states that he gave "some". We need the whole body.

No other apostle was like Paul and could lay out the kind of revelation that he gave. Isn't it interesting that though Paul never knew or walked with Jesus while he was here on earth, yet he still had more revelation of the things of God than did all the apostles who had walked personally with Jesus for years.

If you ask someone to define an apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor or a teacher... what gifts would they say that they operate in? True apostles set patterns in the kingdom of God. The law of things first is mentioned in Ephesians 1:17, 18. If your intellect does not operate in and by the wisdom, revelation and knowledge of God, then it is nothing.

I will gain every thing that I need by Christ who is my wisdom and who gives true revelation and knowledge. I don't care how you are getting your wisdom, revelation or knowledge; if you are not getting it from God it will fail.

People can say what your call is in God but...leaders, elders, Christians if you do not understand the hope of his calling or the knowledge of God you are missing a key foundational pieces. You must use the metron or the measure of faith that God has given to you. If you never give a directional word then I might question whether you are a prophet of God. If you possess the interpretation of tongues it does not make you a prophet or mean that you flow in the prophetic. The pastor has to be able to interpret the word when it comes forth for to the sheep so that he knew whether the word was on or off. Paul had the ability to discern what the hope of others calling were.

Most people are locked up in what God wants them to do. They do not want to minister in many places, they just want to minister in one place. David was anointed seven times. What if God wants you to walk in many different sequences of life in order to come to the revelation of the hope of his calling? It is to fulfill the nature of Jesus Christ. Paul was not trying to get people to believe that he was an apostle. He was trying to put his apostolic shine on the people of God. He wanted each believer to understand his /her calling in God and that they are a treasure. Proverbs 24:3,4 and by knowledge he shall be filled with all treasures. Leaders understand how I am connecting the wisdom, revelation and knowledge of God. The reason Paul fought so hard against those who belittle people is because those people whether they realize it or not are tearing down God's treasures, the saints. We are to mark them and to rebuke them sharply. When you talk about what you feel with no regard for the people of God, it tears them down. True apostles are not afraid to confront mess and bad attitudes. We can not tear down what God is trying to build. You are the priesthood and we must be preserving his kingdom at all costs.



Romans 16-the treasure that Paul found is people.

If someone would begin to tear down the conference I would say, be careful you are kicking against the move of God.

Listen to them as individual treasures, the people of God.

I am going to open up the line for those of you who want to share about your experience with the Lord about our All Nations Worship conference.

Elder Diann-Many things blessed me so much. The highlight was the declaration sharing that he was an apostle watched him carry the weight of the apostolic and has been tried and tested. He was not after the title. That declaration was made public. I encourage you to sow a special seed because he has been declared an apostle and a bishop of God especially for those who have watched.

Min. Tommy-James 2:14-18 faith without works is dead. He is just trying to do the will. It is easy for people to know who you are by what you see. Our father witnessed that he was a son by his declaration of the son. Ephesians 1:18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened. He was not just talking about our eyes. Your ability to understand what you see needs to be enlightened. Whom do men say that I am? Whom do you say that I am?

Elder Jackie-Phenomenal that God brought that declaration out when we were singing thou oh Lord art a shield for me and he had his shield out and was covering the people of God. That God would allow that same kind of an anointing but in a different way. Funny, incredible. Children had come out of there session they all had on a shield, a helmet on their head and had swords and they were swinging them in the air. One of the smaller kids asked to see Pastor Eric's shield. The children were embracing the moment in the way that they could.

Min. Tommy-Matthew 16:5-17 who do men say that I am? It starts out in v. 5 when the disciples had forgotten to take some bread with them. V. 6 Jesus told them to take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees. And they reasoned among themselves, saying, it is because we have taken no bread that he says these things. A lot of times when God is speaking we go to a natural expression of what he is talking about. What he was speaking about was not natural at all. Jesus was trying to convey a spiritual truth when he told them to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod. V. 12 then they understood that he talketh not about the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees. v. 13 we have been on the phone talking about whom do men say that I am? Some of us have been walking with the man of God (Pastor Eric) for 15-20 years. Who do men say that Pastor Eric and Elder Rebecca are? Do we believe in what they do and who they are? Who do you say that they are? Matthew chapter 17:1, 2 Jesus took Peter, James and John up to a high mountain and he was transfigured in their presence. This took place before the word of the Lord had come and yet they were pronouncing who he was ahead of time.

Pastor Eric was singing one of those songs to the Lord, Afterwards I stepped into his office and said although I have been walking with you for years, tonight it was as though you were transfigured in front of me. I saw you larger than life. Though many of us were there, some of us did not see it in the spirit, we perceived it only naturally.

Pastor Eric has just been walking with God not concerned about who men say that he is. He knew that he was an apostle.
